


## WELCOME TO MOUNT MORIAH

How can **Black women** lower their risk of breast cancer?

Despite the statistics, there are many actions that **Black women (and women of any race)** can take to be proactive in when it comes to breast health.

**Find clinics that offer free or low-cost mammograms.** According to the Affordable Health Care Act, insurance companies are required by law to pay for mammograms every year or two for women over the age of 40.

**Find out about your family history.** If you know that you have first-degree relatives that have breast, ovarian, uterine, colon, prostate cancer, or pancreas cancer, you should be genetically counseled. A genetic counselor will be able to test you and interp

**Learn how to perform a self-breast exam.** Knowing your breasts — what's normal, and what's not — can be extremely empowering in preventing and treating breast cancer.
