
WLECOME TO MOUNT MORIAH

MAKING A **DIFFERENCE!**



Mount Moriahi takes seriously the parable Jesus of Nazareth told about who will be included in the future kingdom of God. In the story, a king is separating his sheep from the goats. When the separation is made, the sheep wonder why they were chosen. Jesus replies that it is their acts of kindness to strangers that earned their place in the kingdom. "Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me."

At the heart of this parable to the problem of food insecurity. Many folks consider hunger at Thanksgiving but a problem this large requires a year-round commitment.
